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


Open Badge Passport is certified by **1EdTech** and follows the 2.0 version of the standard.

# How to accept a badge issued to you

- You can accept a badge via an email link or by signing into your OBP account and accepting the badge
- From the badge's Share tab you can make your badge public
- Public badges can be shared in different social media channels or as links
